In the fall of 2014, we started the Central-Southeastern Wrestling Taskforce to raise money for our school's wrestling programs. Our school is located in a very rural part of Illinois. We were trying to come up with various fundraising ideas to reach our goals. One of our taskforce members attended a Greg Warren show. After the show, he approached Greg and explained our group and what we wanted to accomplish. Greg was very receptive to helping us out.

After finding a date that worked for both us and Greg, we began developing our event. We found local businesses and individuals to donate items for a Silent auction, a local HyVee catered the dinner, we had door prizes, raffle, and a "Happy Hour." Greg was our headliner and performed for approximately 130 people. We sold advance tickets and even had a few people show up at the door to see Greg's show. The first dinner was considered a great success. Several people commented that they would spread the word for next year.

In the summer of 2015, we contacted Greg's agent and began working on dates for Greg to again be our performer, for our second Comedy Night. This time we secured a local venue, located within our school district boundaries, and had the event closer to our community. We were able to acquire more donations and bigger prizes. We had a caterer grill on site this time. Greg performed for over an hour during the second show. He even had some crowd participation with a local teacher, which was considered a highlight by the crowd.

The Comedy night dinners have raised approximately \$15,000 towards our goal. Greg's extensive wrestling background and love of the sport has made him an excellent fit for us. He has become synonymous with our project as well, and we often get asked when we are having him back. Greg's feel for the crowd and their attitudes has been very astute. Prior to performing, Greg asked the demographics of the audience. We have chosen to have an 18 and over crowd, he informed me that if there were families at the event, he would perform at a G/PG level. Greg was able to read the crowd and has never gone "over the line" in either of his performances.
